adidas

The sportswear manufacturer, blocked the Black Lives Matter movement from trademarking a design that featured three parallel stripes. The company had said in a filing that the Black Lives Matter Global Network Foundation (BLMGNF) designs would create confusion with its own brand look and feel.

BLMGNF was founded after the unarmed black teenager Trayvon Martin was shot by the neighbourhood watch volunteer George Zimmerman and rose to prominence during the global movement of protests that followed the killing of George Floyd by a white police officer. Adidas made an abrupt U-turn after negative PR which led to fears that the public could misinterpret their objection as criticism of BLMGNF's mission. Black lives matter, adidas ~ three stripes don't.

Barclays: Fluent in lying

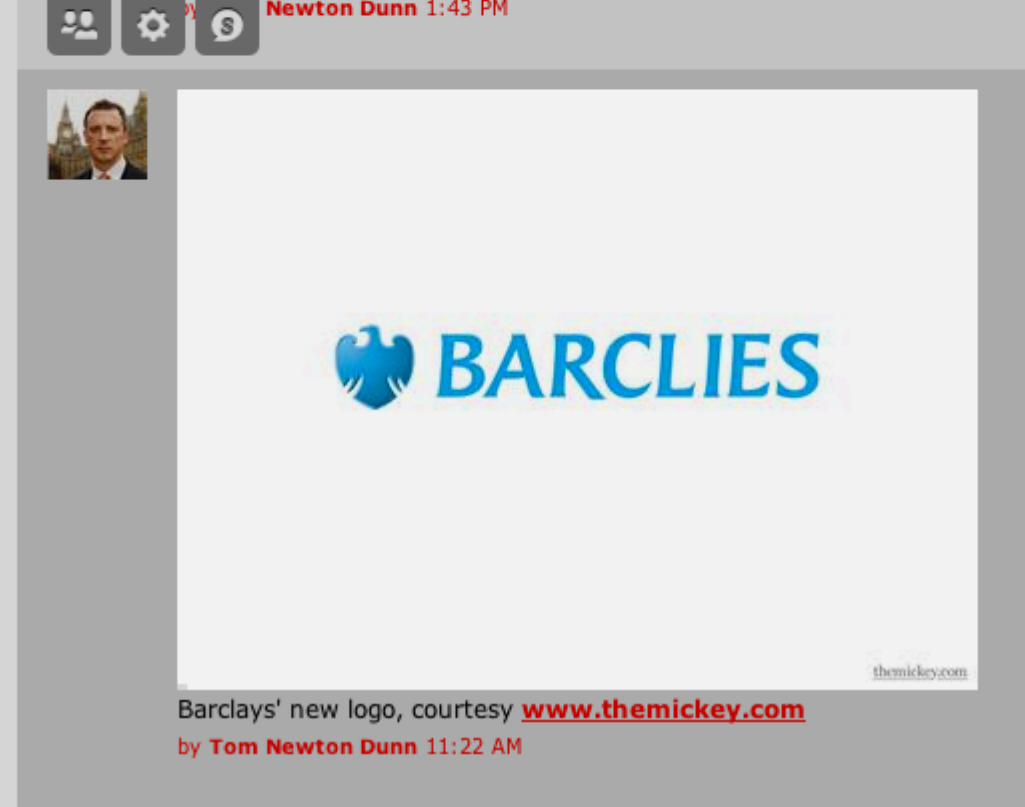

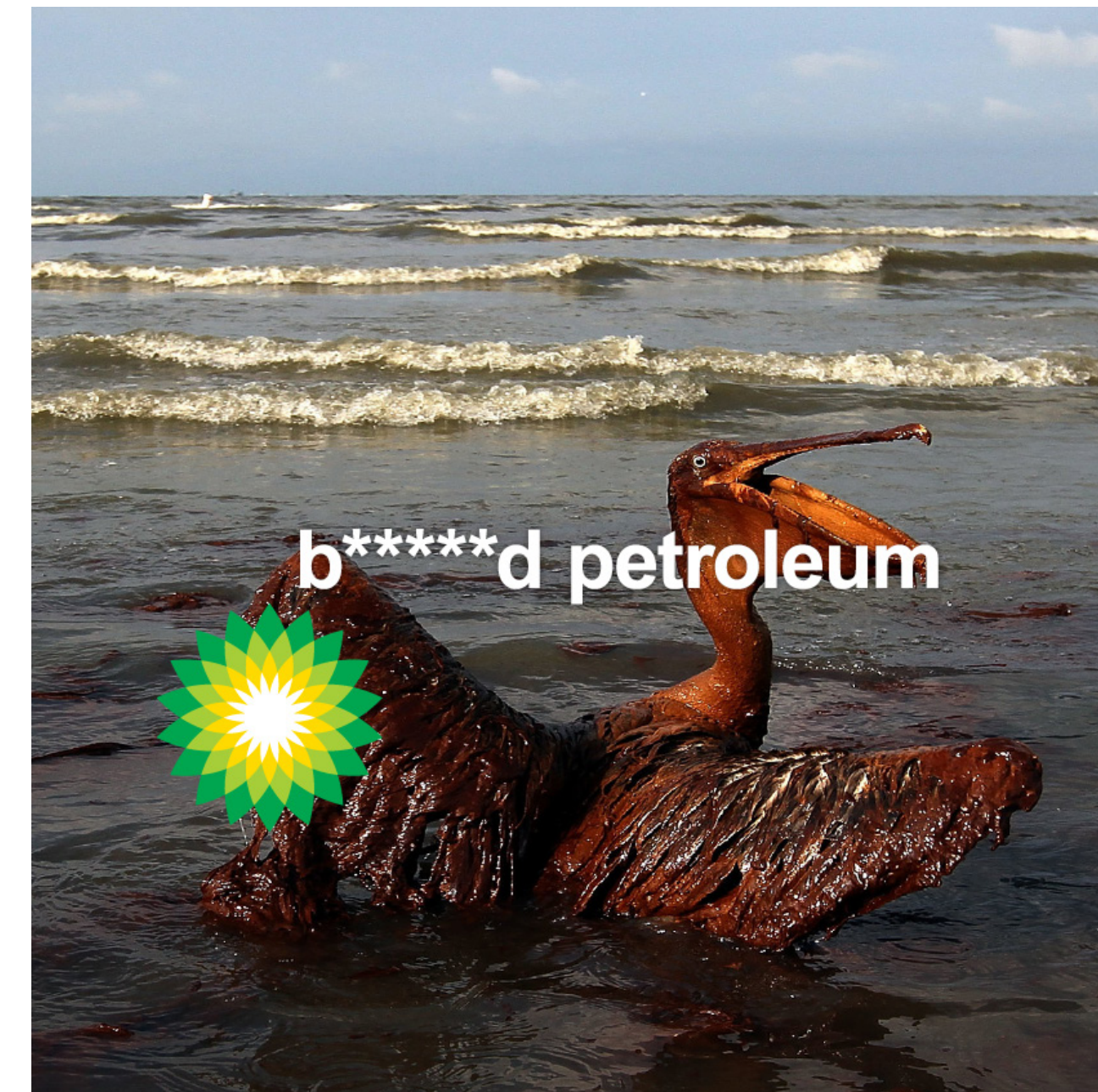

Coutts Bank

Founded in 1692, Coutts is the eighth oldest bank in the world. It forms part of NatWest Group's wealth management division. Until the 20th century Coutts was a clearing bank to the nobility and landed gentry, but then became a wealth manager to a wider range of clients, including entrepreneurs, entertainers, sportsmen, professionals, executives, lottery winners, and football players. The British Royal Family are notable clients ~ the bank was sometimes referred to as 'the Kings's bank'.

In 2023, former MEP and UKIP leader Nigel Farage had his personal and business accounts closed by Coutts. An internal document described Mr Farage as a 'disingenuous grifter' who promoted 'xenophobic, chauvinistic and racist views', and said his 'views were at odds with our position as an inclusive organisation'. Coutts responded by saying that 'Decisions to close accounts are not taken lightly and take into account a number of factors including commercial viability, reputational considerations, and legal and regulatory requirements' and that Mr Farage 'was offered alternative banking facilities with NatWest.'

Dame Alison Rose, Group CEO of the NatWest Group, confessed to being the source of a BBC report and admitted to a "serious error of judgement" in discussing Mr Farage's accounts with a financial journalist from the BBC. She later resigned her position as did chief executive Peter Flavel.

In 2021, Malaysia's tainted sovereign wealth fund, 1MDB, sued Coutts for \$1.03 billion claiming, 'negligence, breach of contract, conspiracy to defraud/injure, and/or dishonest assistance'.

In 2020, Swiss authorities convicted a former Coutts & Co. banker for failing to report suspicious transactions linked to 1MDB and in 2017 Swiss markets watchdog FINMA ordered Coutts & Co to pay Swiss francs 6.5 million for breaching money-laundering regulations in its business linked to 1MDB.

In 2012, Coutts was fined £8.75m for breaches of money laundering rules after 'serious' and 'systemic' problems in handling the affairs of 'politically exposed persons', customers entrusted with a prominent public function, requiring money-laundering checks.

In 2011, the Financial Services Authority (FSA) fined Coutts £6.3m for mis-selling the American International Group (AIG) Enhanced Variable Rate Fund, which invested a significant proportion of its assets in riskier asset-backed securities.

The multi-millionaire Tory donor Javad Marandi, who owns The Conran Shop, was revealed as a key figure linked to a major money laundering operation targeted by the National Crime Agency.

A court ruling said that bank records showed that Mr Marandi, who has been on a Conservative advisory board of ultra-wealthy supporters, either owned or was connected to companies involved in a 'criminal enterprise' moving vast sums of illicit funds around the world and into the UK. Conman?

Facebook

Global Science Research (GSR) harvested data from millions of Facebook users without their explicit consent. The wording in the privacy policy allowed apps to access private details about users' friends. These details were later sold to Cambridge Analytica, who used it to create highly-targeted ads to encourage users to vote for Trump and Brexit. Nothing is private and nothing is safe on Snoopbook – what Zuckerberg's company is really all about.



Greggs

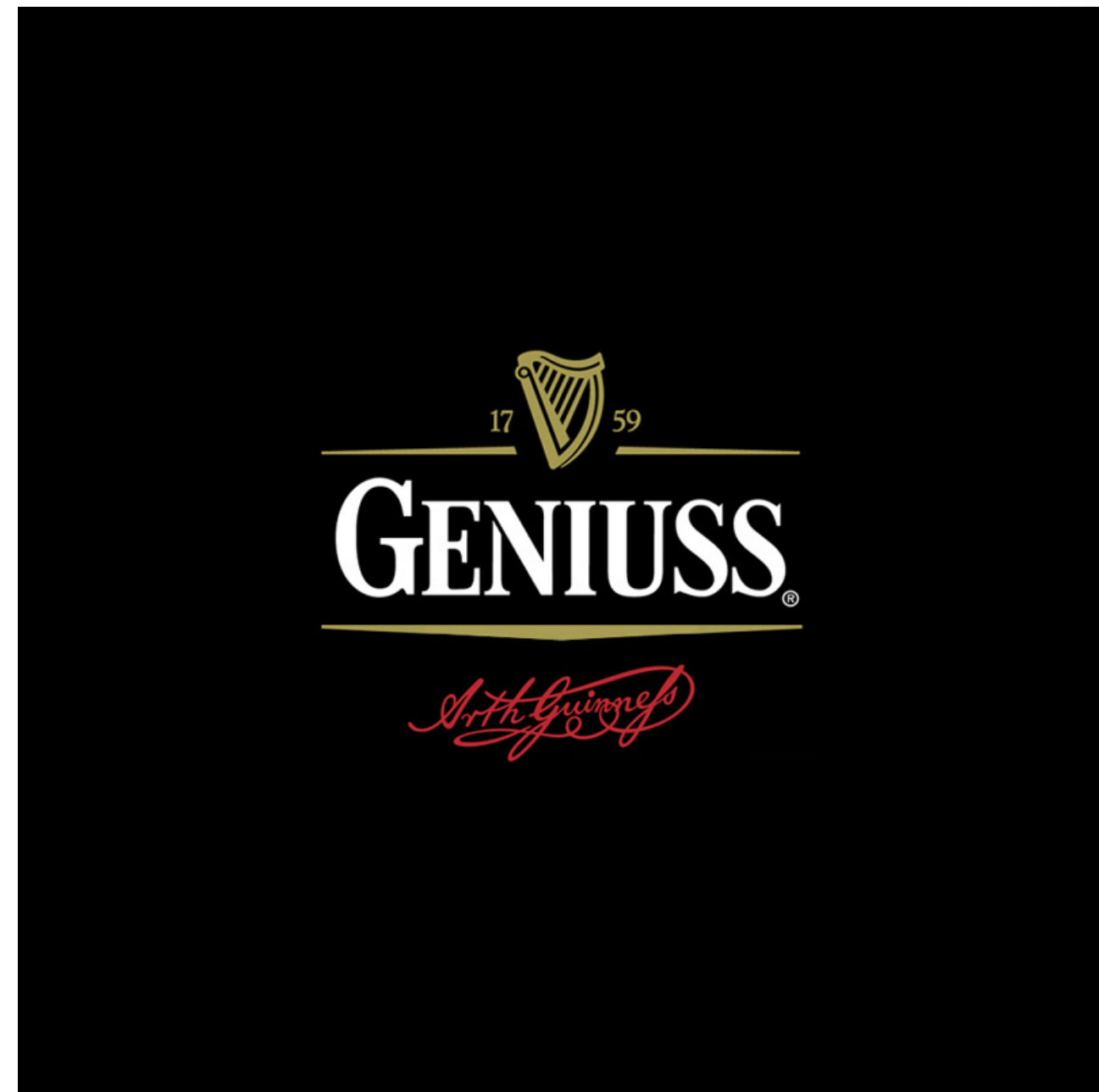
Colin Gregg, the 75 year old son of the founder of the Greggs bakers chain was jailed for 13.5 years having been convicted of nine counts of indecent assault on four boys over a period of decades. Gregg, who helped build up the family business and also worked as a social worker, abused his positions of trust as a teacher and headteacher to sexually abuse boys, Judge Robin Mairs said.

Gregg, abused one victim in a swimming pool, the others were molested in a gym, his study or a car. The judge said: "It is true you have enjoyed great wealth, privilege and social standing. This was sophisticated predatory behaviour, you are a sophisticated predatory paedophile."



G4S

The security giant received a £284m contract to provide 13,700 guards for the 2012 Olympic Games. Only 16 days before the Games were to begin, the company admitted that it had not managed to recruit enough people. As a result, an extra 3,500 military personnel had to be drafted in at the last moment. Well done G4Shit.

Executives at HSBC admitted that staff at its global subsidiaries laundered billions of dollars for drug cartels, terrorists and pariah states. It's good to know that the world's local bank is doing valuable work in the community.

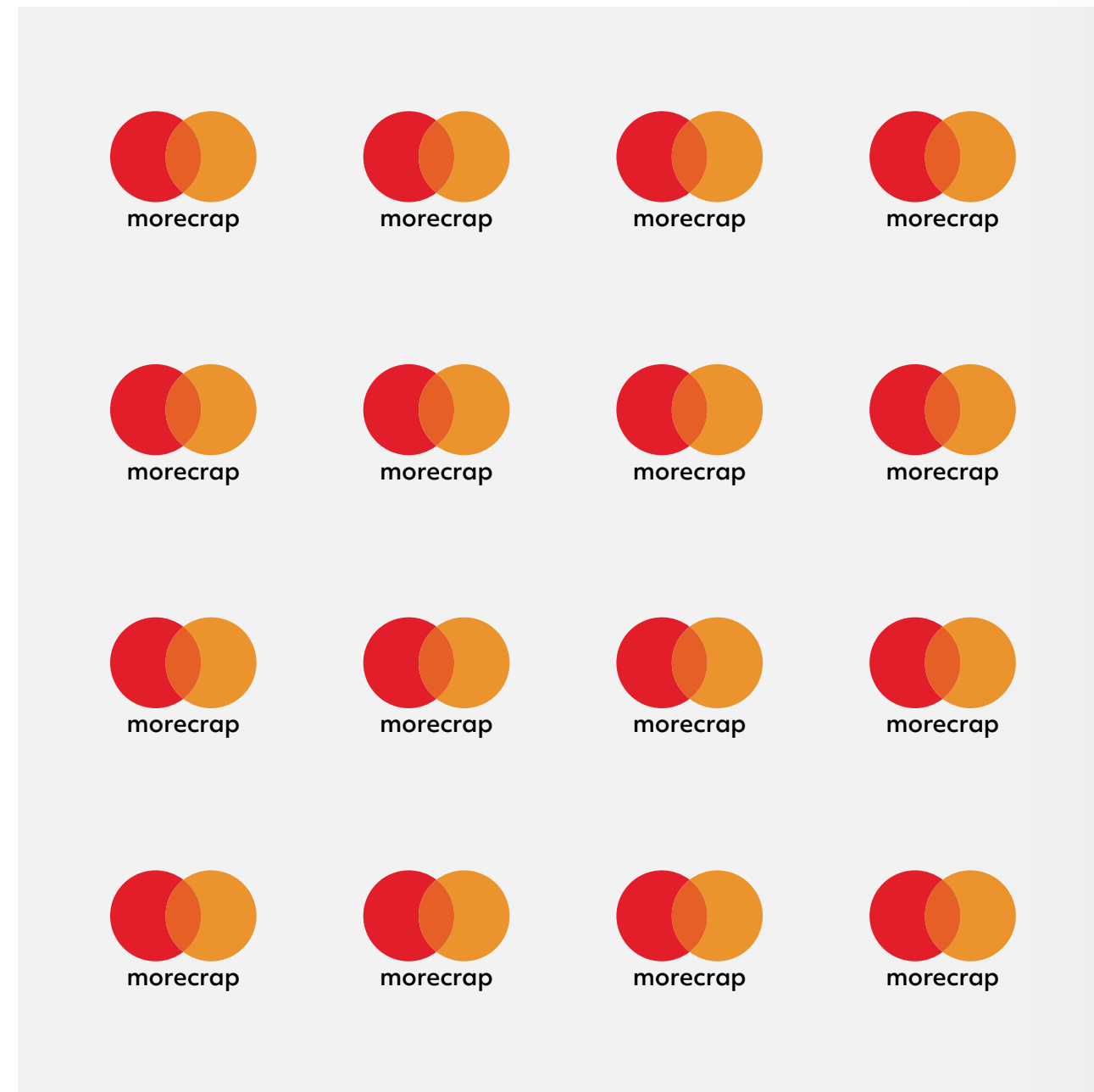

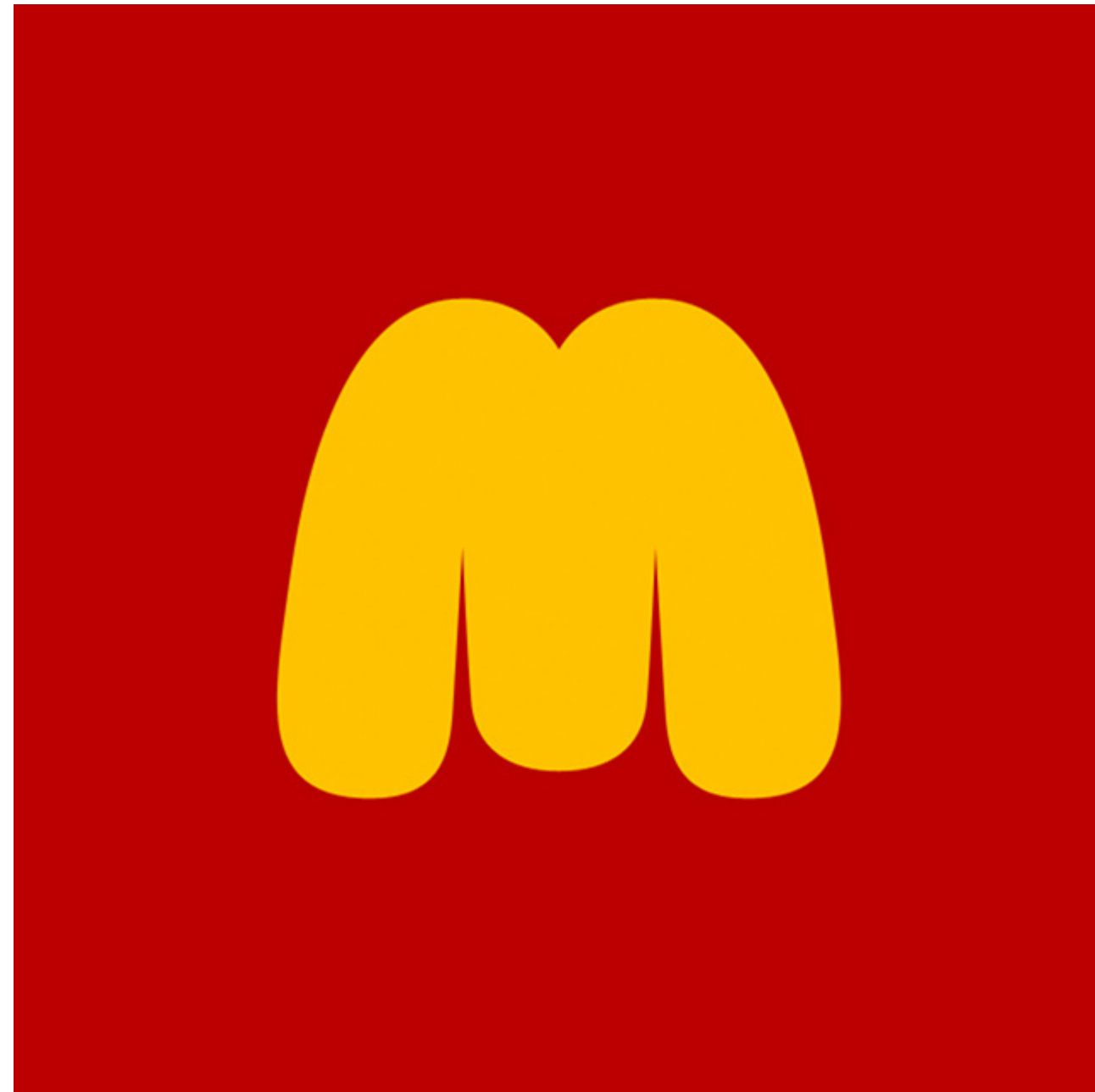

P&O

In 2022, P&O Ferries employees received a short pre-recorded video message in which they were told: "Your final day of employment is today". P&O then sacked 800 staff and replaced them with cheaper agency workers.

UK law requires any employer planning 20 or more staff redundancies to consult with their staff, and their trade union representatives within a 90-day period. Additionally, companies planning to make more than 100 redundancies must also inform the business secretary 45 days in advance. The company knowingly broke the law when it fired workers without any formal notice.

P&O's brand values state they would like to "Inspire our people and continue to develop outstanding teams who are determined to exceed customer expectations" and "Lead the industry in setting the standards for best practice in wellbeing". What a load of tosh. A company is its services and its people – an asset they clearly do not value. P&O... shorthand for "Piss Off" more like. I certainly won't be using their services in the future.



Primark

Primark was battling to save its reputation after more revelations of illegal labour practices and poor working conditions in its supply chain. One UK suppliers was found to be employing illegal workers and paying staff less than the minimum wage. Nice work nomarks.

SIEMENS

Siemens

Since the 1990s, Siemens had organised a global system of corruption to gain market share and increase its price. It was able to get away with this because of big loopholes in the legal systems of a host of countries, including Germany. Bribes became the accepted business norm at Siemens, they were channelled through hidden bank accounts, obscure intermediaries and pseudo 'consultants'. When calculating the cost of a project, Siemens employees used 'nützliche aufwendungen', a common tax term literally translated as 'useful expenditures' or internally understood as 'bribes'.

Following the US and German prosecutions, Siemens paid more than \$1.6 billion in fines, penalties and disgorgement of profits, including \$800 million to US authorities. This was the largest monetary sanction ever imposed in a case under America's Foreign Corruption Practice Act since it was passed in 1977. Wankers.



Starbucks

The Sun

Coverage of the 1989 Hillsborough disaster by the British tabloid 'The Sun' led to the newspaper's decline in Liverpool and the broader Merseyside region, with organised boycotts against it. The disaster occurred at a football match between Liverpool and Nottingham Forest where ninety-seven Liverpool supporters were crushed to death, and several hundred others were injured, due to negligence by the South Yorkshire Police. On 19 April 1989, four days after the incident, The Sun published a front-page story with the headline 'The Truth' containing a number of falsehoods alleging that Liverpool supporters were responsible for the accident.

Don't buy The Sun.



Toyota

Not that long ago Toyota recalled 75,000 cars in the UK as part of a global recall of 2.8 million cars because of steering wheel problems. Prior to that a faulty accelerator pedal led to 10 million cars being taken off the road. The company later admitted the faults were caused by over-hasty expansion, and was fined \$1.2 billion by US regulators over misleading statements about safety problems with its cars. If the car in front, or behind is a Toyota, be careful.

VW: Dieselgate
